There is still a lot of time before we must finish it but I think we must start preparing it. I have found some information about Lake Jack London. I think this information is fascinating. In fact, Jack London is a famous American writer who has never been to Russia but there is some interesting information about a lake named after him.

It is in the Magadan Region in the east of our country where the winter is very frosty while the highest temperature in summer is +12 °C. So this place is not popular with tourists.

The most common legend about the origin of the name is that when geologists reached the lake, they found a volume of Jack London’s novel “Martin Eden” on its shores. Well, that sounds romantic, but not very realistic.

I have found some information about the novel too. The main character of the novel, Martin Eden, was a poor worker and sailor. London wrote the book in 1909, after he returned from Alaska, where he was trying to find some gold.

However, this legend became very popular among local people, and now there is a fun local custom – people who are able to reach the lake leave a copy of “Martin Eden” on the shore of the lake, so that others who come here may find it.
