Listening Comprehension (10 minutes)

Listen to the dialogue between the parents of a boy named Philip and answer the following questions. You will hear the dialogue twice. Now you have 30 seconds to look through the questions.

Now we are ready to start.

Father: Hey, Anna, do you remember what month it is?

Mother: Of course, I do, George! How can I forget our son's birthday? He will turn 11 years old!

Father: Philip will be 11 in just two weeks! Unbelievable! Let's choose a gift for him while he is at school.

Mother: Good idea! He still loves puzzles, doesn't he? Which puzzle will it be this time?

Father: I know that he is dreaming of a 3-D puzzle, some kind of model of a famous building. He's never had one like that. Can I show you something on my computer? Here's a great online shop that sells all these puzzles.

Mother: Wow! Look at that! Here! The Moscow Kremlin looks great!

Father: Actually, Philip told me that he had helped one of his friends make a 3-D puzzle of the Moscow Kremlin. You know – his friend John?

Mother: Oh, yes! Well, if he has already done it, let's choose something else. How about Big Ben in London? Or the White House in Washington, D.C.? Do they have them?

Father: I'm sure they do. Here they are. Wait. They each have over 3 thousand pieces and take more than 15 hours to complete. And the pieces are metal. They are not for children.

Mother: No, that won't do. Oh, look! Here's a pretty Russian church! I think it's from St. Petersburg.

Father: Let's see. Actually, it's St. Basil's Cathedral from Red Square in Moscow. It was built by Ivan the Terrible in the 16th century.

Mother: Philip will love it! He loves history!

Father: Yes! So, it has one thousand pieces and will take about 10 hours. And the pieces are not metal.

Mother: Perfect! How much is it?

Father: It's usually 40 dollars, but now it's on sale for only 22 dollars.

Mother: It's almost 50% off!

Father: 45% to be exact.

Mother: Great! Go ahead and buy it!

Father: Done!

You'll hear the dialogue again in 30 seconds.

(pause 30 seconds)

Now listen to the dialogue again.

(Dialogue repeated)

Now you have two minutes to finish the task.
